

Craft Club – Mixed Materials Lab: Plush Toy Making Class! Session 2

Class Instruction

Get ready to unleash your creativity in the Mixed Materials Lab: Plush Toy Making Class! In this fun-filled, hands-on course, children will immerse themselves in engaging experiments with fabric, sewing, yarn art, clay, and metal accessories, and design and create their own plush toys and cushions. Each week, young makers will explore new material combinations—from soft plush fabrics and fluffy stuffing to colorful yarn for creating textured backgrounds and collages, and super light clay. They will learn basic sewing skills, sculpt adorable toy parts, wrap and glue yarn into creative "yarn paintings," and combine various elements to create unique, personalized plush toys.

We'll also incorporate collage and yarn art elements: students will design artwork using yarn, paper, textiles, and mixed materials. This course aims to inspire children's imaginations, encourage hands-on problem-solving, and ensure that every child takes home a piece they can be proud of. Whether it's making a cozy cushion or piecing together a uniquely shaped toy and its yarn artwork, children of all interests and skill levels will enjoy this multi-material adventure that blends sewing, sculpting, yarn art, decorating, and storytelling. Join us to explore, create, and sew a toy with your own hands—and achieve your dream!
