Class Introduction

Our writing program empowers students to become skilled communicators and creative storytellers. Each class features a “word of the day,” a focused grammar lesson, and time to write and develop stories. Students learn to organize ideas, use descriptive language, and express themselves with clarity.

Our winter and spring sessions introduce new writing styles—such as persuasive, expository, and personal narrative—ensuring returning students to encounter fresh content and continue to grow without repetition.

At the academy, she teaches science, public speaking, and writing, blending confidence-building with personalized instruction.
